**Activity Description** Based on understanding the rules of football matches, design and plan a table football game with children. Formulate the game's process and rules, and be able to organize the game and follow the rules. Use building blocks to complete the game's process design and planning through hands-on operation.

### Interactive Tips

- Ask children to freely express their opinions and discuss what tools are needed for table football. First formulate the general content of the rules, and improve them later.
- The size of the goalposts should be compared with the small ball; an inappropriate size will affect the game experience.
- The ball-striking tools for table football must be more sturdy, so use the interlocking structure for building.
