- Activity Objectives**
- ☑ Learn about the characteristics of fruits, such as their color, aroma, and taste.
 - ☑ Be able to imitate fruit shapes for building through observation and comparison, and practice the ability to handle details.

Activity Description Host a unique "Fruit Party" with children. Fruits have bright colors and diverse shapes. To build vivid fruit models by hand, children need to carefully observe, compare, and imitate—this is a good test of their ability to handle details during building.



Interactive Tips

- The key and difficult part of building is to simulate fruit shapes based on real fruits. This requires children to observe and compare more. Adult instructors can give suggestions when children choose blocks of different shapes, but should not interfere with their judgments.
- Interact with children during building, so that they can think more and make adjustments to the handling of details.
