- ☑ Understand the external characteristics and living habits of crocodiles.
 - ☑ Learn about the traits of reptiles by building a crocodile with hands.

Activity Description Through observation, children will find that crocodiles have typical features: four limbs, scaly skin, and a very large mouth. Crocodiles can swim in water and crawl on land. Children will imitate and build a crocodile, and further handle the details of the structure accurately to make it more realistic. This activity specifically trains children's observation and hands-on abilities.
