Applicable Age Group 3-4 year-old toddlers

- Activity Objectives**
- ☑ Understand the living habits of snails.
 - ☑ Learn about the function of a snail's shell through observation and comparison.

Activity Description You will search for snails with children "after rain", observe their appearance and movement methods, and understand their living habits. Then, use building blocks of different shapes to imitate the snail's appearance, and help children learn that a snail's shell can shelter it from wind and rain and protect it from harm.

Interactive Tips

- The focus is on observing the snail's appearance, comparing it, and then imitating and building. Therefore, encourage children to observe the shape of the snail's shell more and think about which building blocks can best replicate it.
- Although the number of building blocks used is not large, how children combine and arrange them determines the final shape of the snail. Thus, the building of detailed parts is quite challenging.
