- ☑ Explore combination and arrangement methods of building blocks in different colors and shapes.
 - ☑ Improve oral expression skills by describing garden scenes.

Activity Description Work with children to use building blocks of different colors and shapes. By changing the combination and arrangement of the blocks, construct colorful flower shapes—this fully inspires and stimulates children’s imagination and creativity. Encourage children to observe the rich changes in block combinations, use their hands and brains, and exercise hand-brain coordination.

Interactive Tips

- When matching colors, guide children to use two colors for each flower; the flower can be made in one or two shapes.
- If a child’s block selection or construction lacks order, communicate with them by asking questions like "What shape is your flower?" or "What kind of flower is this, and how many petals does it have?" Let the child adjust while thinking.
