- Activity Objectives**
- ☑ Observe and understand the characteristics and living habits of horses.
 - ☑ Accurately build a horse model by imitating its details.

Activity Description Through verbal descriptions, children will learn about the appearance features and body structure of horses. They will use building blocks to create a horse model, pose it in a running posture, and understand the state of a horse when it gallops. During scene construction, they will also learn about the living habits and living environment of horses.

Interactive Tips

- To more accurately represent the horse's shape, it is best to choose colors that are close to real horses.
- The key parts of the horse model are the head and tail; remind children to observe these parts carefully during construction.
- It is quite difficult to make the imitation realistic, so encourage children to make more attempts and adjustments.
