- Activity Objectives**

 - ☑ Improve fine motor skills of the hands through block building.

Activity Description Through a series of interactive sessions, children not only gain a better understanding of the Tyrannosaurus Rex, a prehistoric animal, but also develop their hands-on ability, observation skills, and team spirit. During the building process, children need to use spatial imagination and hands-on ability to combine blocks into the Tyrannosaurus Rex image they have in mind.
