Interactive Tips

- Children can start building block castles in groups or independently. Adult coaches should provide guidance on the side, reminding children to pay attention to elements such as a stable foundation, clear layers, and color matching.
- Encourage children to try different building methods. When they encounter problems, guide them to think actively about solutions, and adult coaches should offer help in a timely manner.
