Activity Objectives

- ☑ Understand the appearance characteristics and living habits of elks.
- ☑ Explore creative block combination methods through observing and building details.

Activity Description Learn about the appearance characteristics and living habits of the "four 不像" (literally "four not like", a common Chinese name for elk, referring to its mixed features resembling deer, horse, cow, and donkey) elk with children, and identify the differences between male and female elks. During the hands-on building process, through observation and continuous attempts, further explore creative block combination methods and detailed building skills.

- Build from bottom to top to ensure the integrity and stability of each structure. Guide children to use building methods such as interlocking and symmetry for some structures.
- The antlers of elks are very distinctive, so the type of blocks selected is crucial. Encourage children to try multiple times to find suitable block shapes.
