

# Magical Treehouse

**Applicable Age Group** 4-5 year-old toddlers

- Activity Objectives**
- ☑ Understand the structure and characteristics of treehouses.
  - ☑ Explore the stability of suspended structures through creative building.

**Activity Description** Discover and build a magical treehouse together. First, learn about its structure and characteristics—treehouses need to be built on thick, sturdy trees and require climbing up and down. Use these descriptions to inspire children’s imagination for creative building, and explore methods to ensure the stability of suspended structures during the building process.

### Interactive Tips

- The tree only needs to have a certain height; it doesn’t need to be too tall, as that would increase the difficulty.
- Building a suspended structure at a certain height is quite challenging for builders. Remind children to use a baseplate for support, such as the floor of the treehouse.
- Since this is creative building, after ensuring stability, let children take charge of building other parts to realize their unique creative ideas.
