- When building, first establish a stable foundation, especially for the Transformer's legs or support structure, to ensure overall stability.
- Pay attention to the weight distribution of blocks and components, avoid being top-heavy which can lead to collapse.
- When using screws and other connectors, ensure the connection is secure to prevent loosening.
